Once upon a time

ANCIENT ROGGE (artificial canals)
Two irrigation ditches, derived from the Fersina stream, brought water to factories, wash-houses and fountains in Pergine and flowed into the nearby marshes reclaimed in the late 1700s.

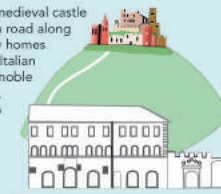
CONTRADA TODESCA

In the 1500s, Pergine was an important mining centre which hosted the mining judgement administering the deposits of wide territories. The miners arrived mainly from Germany and the homes of German families, the metal market, as well as the Judge palace were mainly located in a district called 'Contrada Todesca'.



CONTRADA TALIANA

Pergine has a beautiful medieval castle on the Tegazzo hill and a road along which are located stately homes belonging to families of Italian origin, some of them of noble lineage. The broad road, in Renaissance style, was called the 'Taliana' road as opposed to the 'Todesca' one.



NEW TOWN

Borgo nuovo (New Town) differs from the other two older roads. It hosted: the postal and telegraph services, tanneries, mills, the slaughterhouse, the spinning mill and the town hall with the customs offices.
